John becomes involved in drugs and crime, often getting into fights and finally is sent to the Pine Hills Correctional Facility. He is eventually released to the Tom Roy Youth Guidance Home (a Youth Homes program) where he begins to flourish. He learns the benefits of hard work and saving money. And he earns his GED just before he graduates from the Tom Roy Home. Eventually he gathers enough money to move out on his own.

Today, he holds two part time jobs, has his own apartment and lives independently. He enjoys Hip Hop dance at a local studio in his free time and stays in contact with friends and staff at the home. John is a great example of what a young adult can achieve during their time at the Tom Roy Youth Guidance Home. "We are proud to be raising dollars to support programs like the Tom Roy Youth Guidance Home and their mission to give all kids who are aging 'out of care' the opportunity to succeed, be healthy and contribute to our community" says owner John Roemer.
